

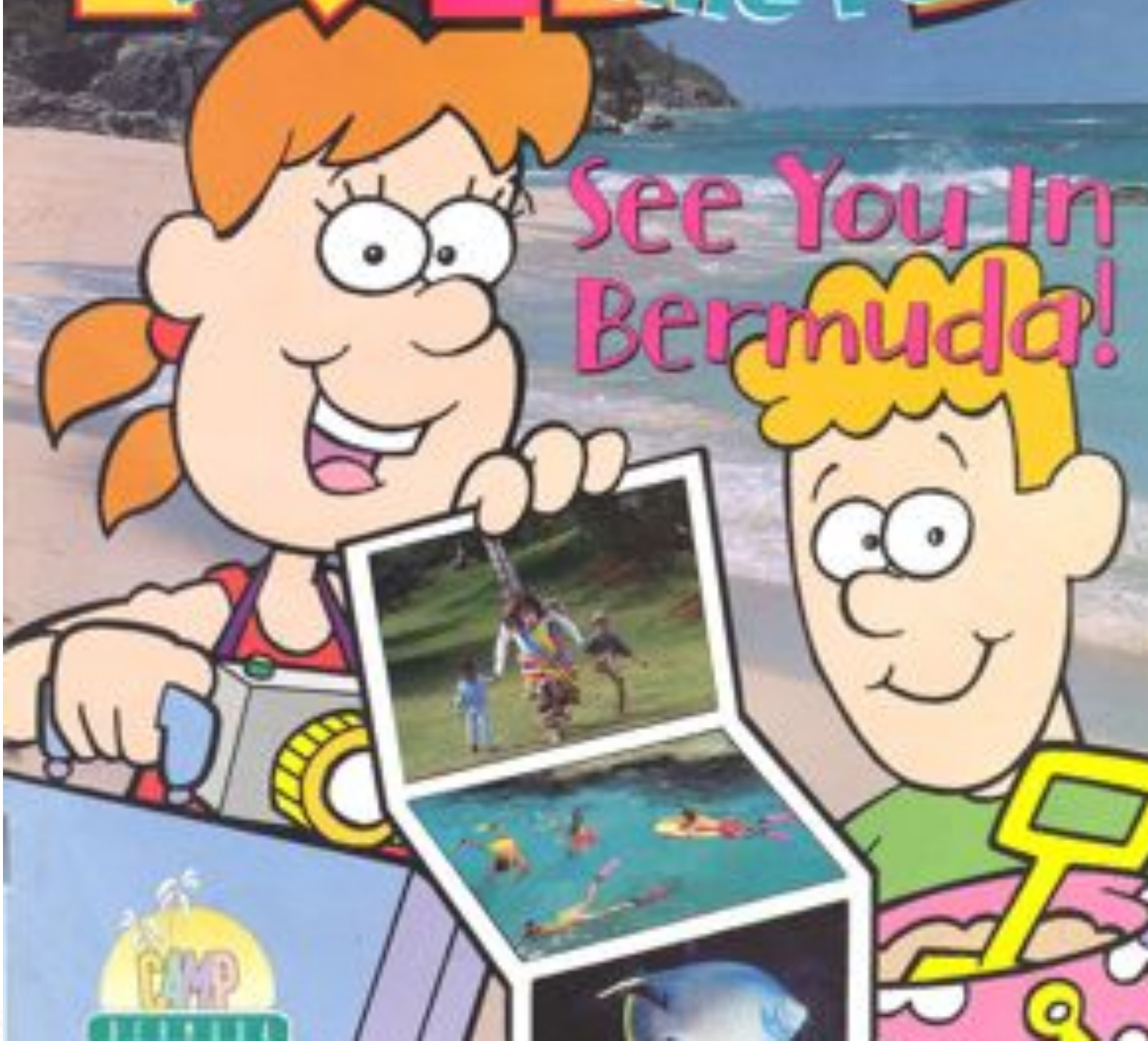

A letter from Katie



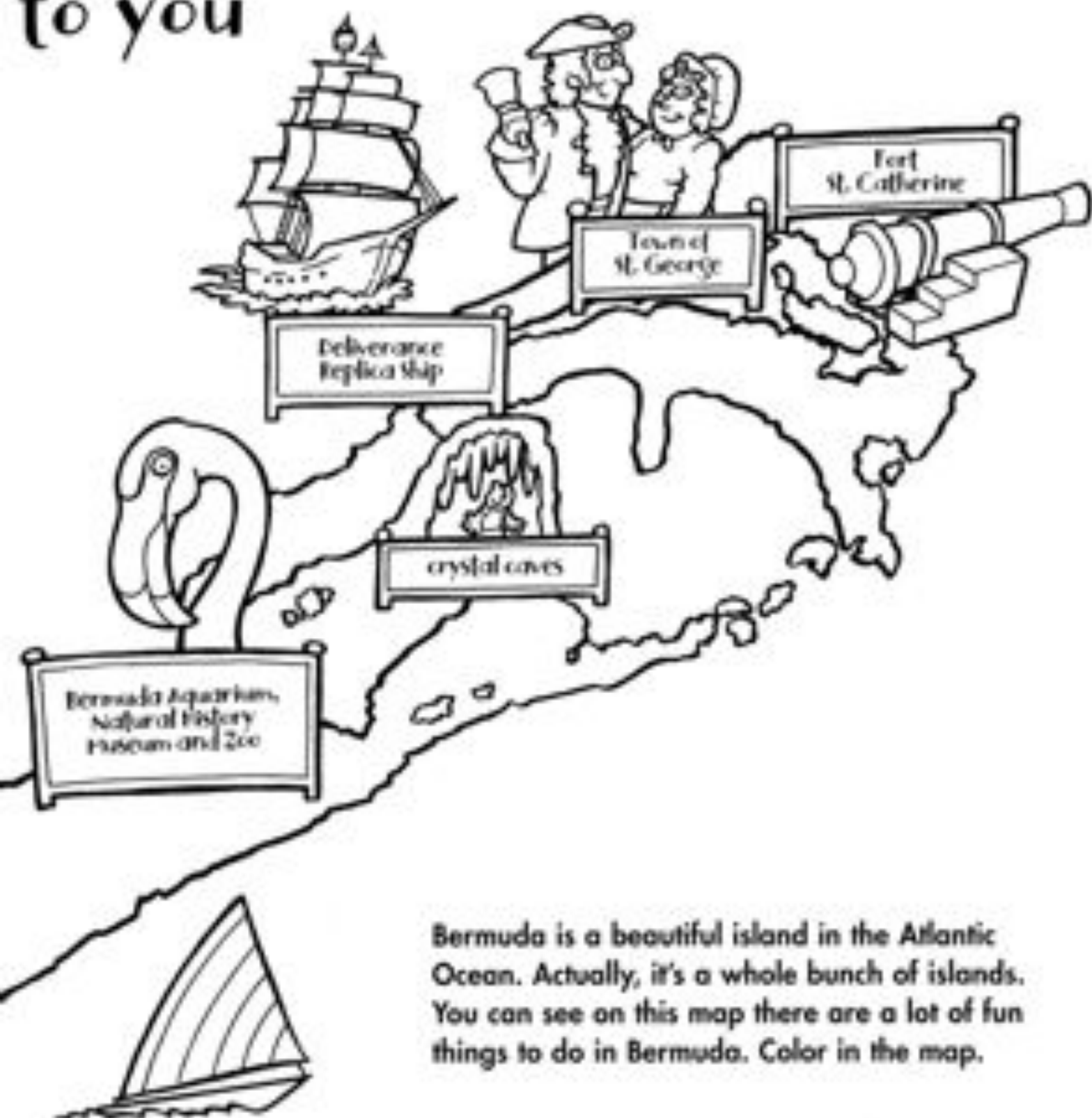
Hi!

coolest vacation.



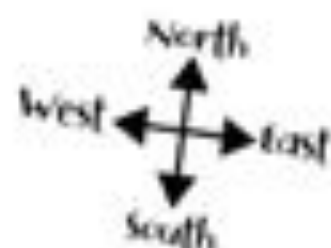
We started our trip in

It was a fast trip!



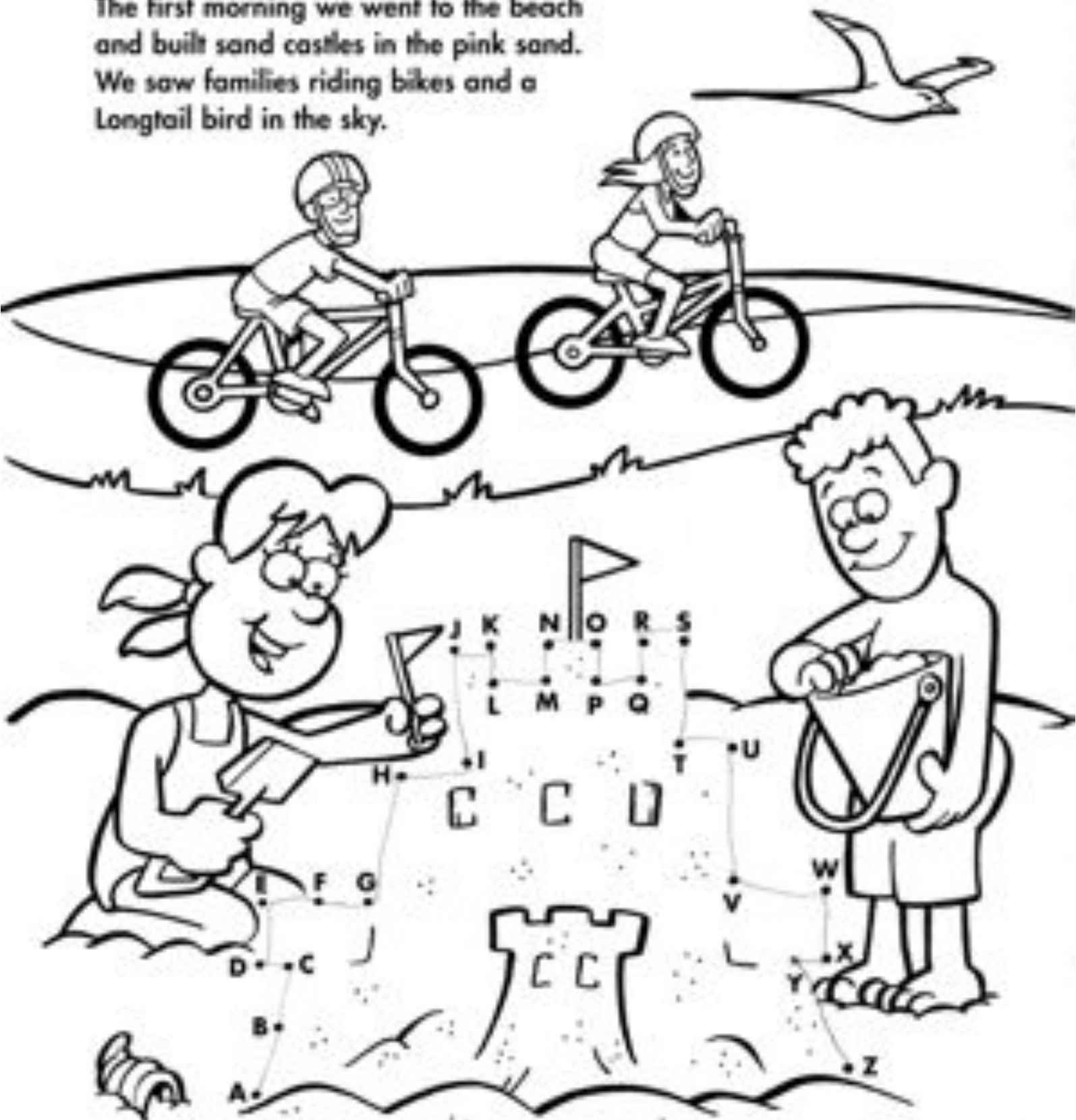

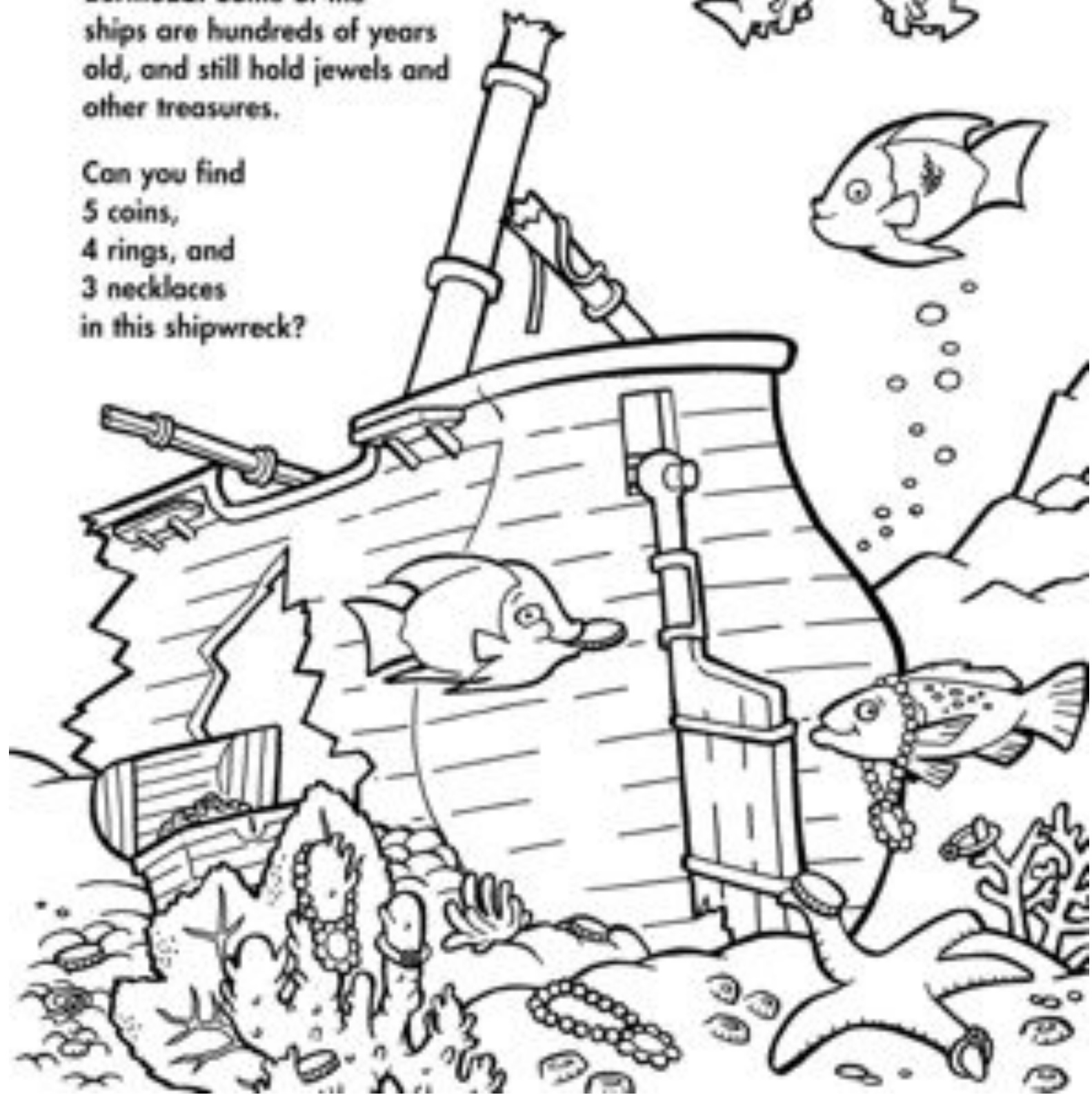
The first morning we went to the beach and built sand castles in the pink sand. We saw families riding bikes and a Longtail bird in the sky.

in this shipwreck?

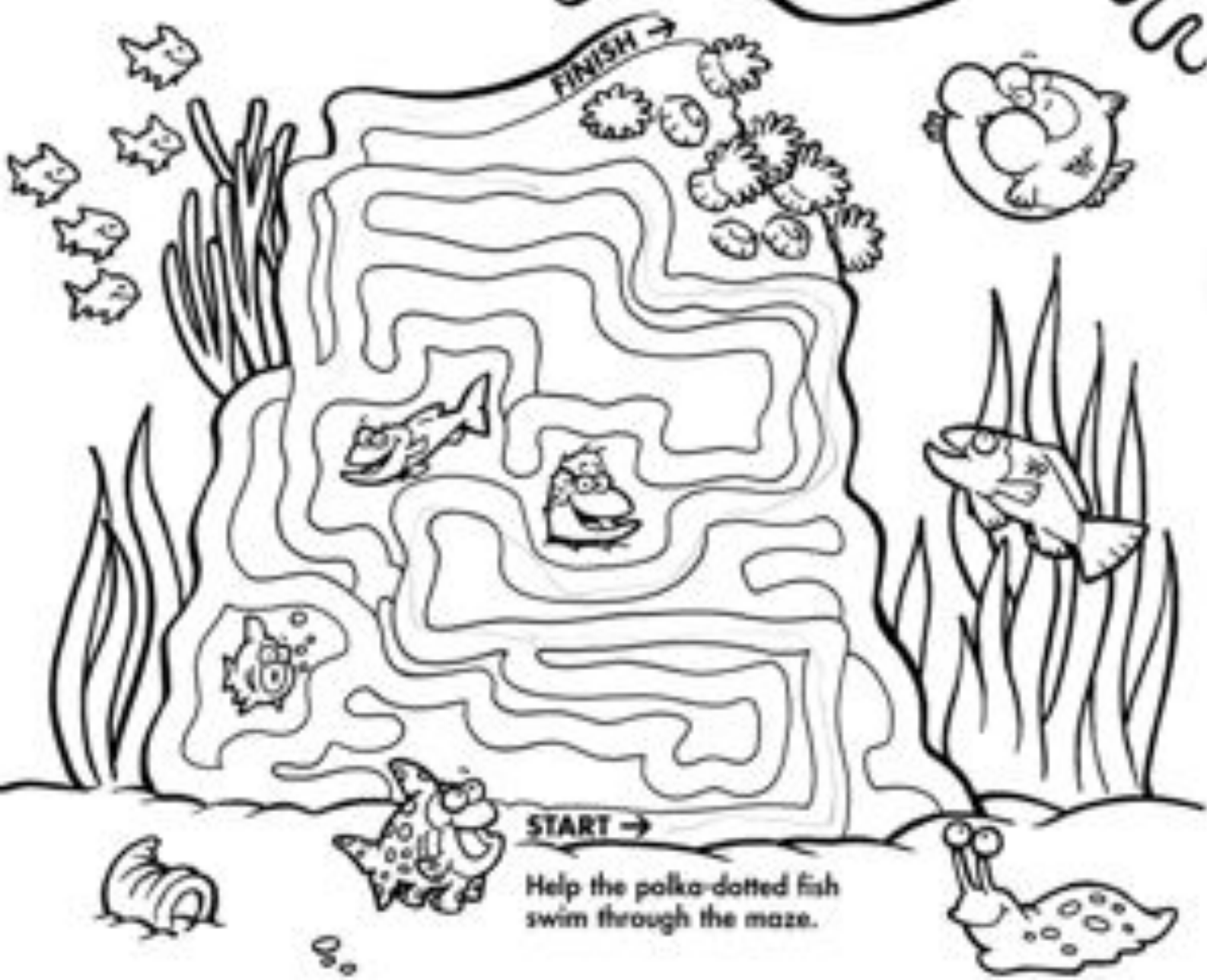
